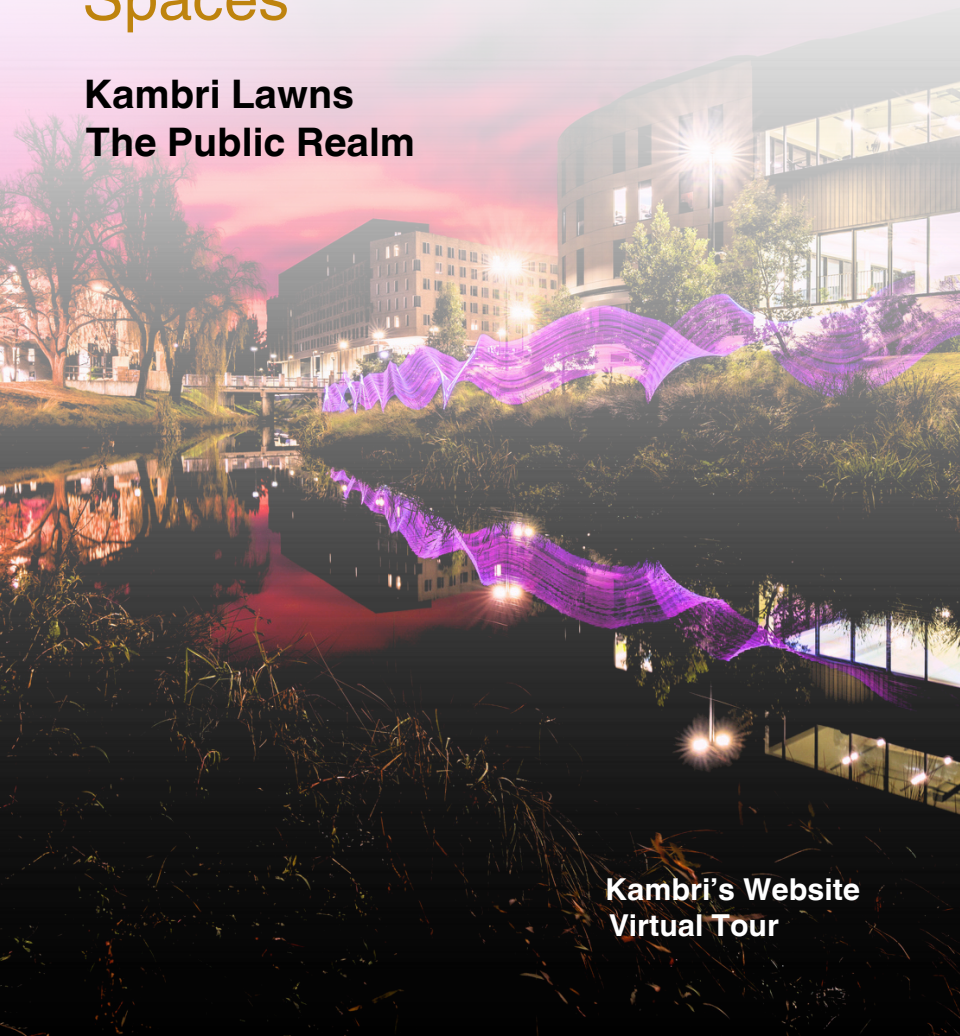

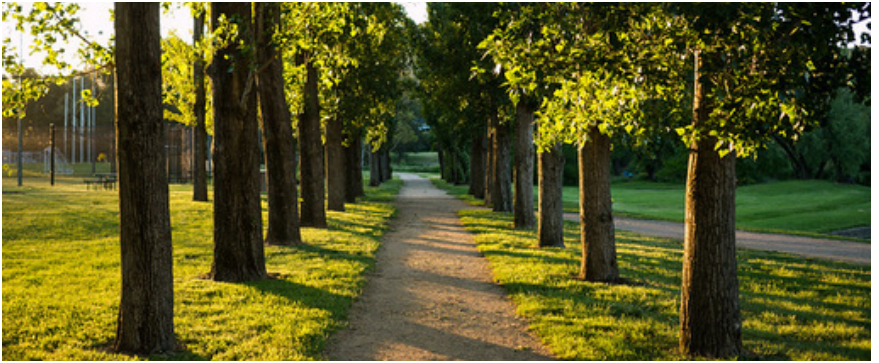


Kambri Lawns

Surrounded by landscaped gardens, local retailers and public seating, the Lawn is the lively heart of Kambri. Soak up the sun and the knowledge in the wide-open spaces, or Grab a book from Harry Hartog, and sit in the landscaped gardens under one of the growing trees. The new town centre of ANU, it's a great setting for markets, live music gigs and public gatherings, with visitors relaxing on beanbags or reclining on the grass.

Green design thinking

The entire precinct was designed and delivered using the One Planet methodology, a quantitative measure of human demand versus supply of nature. The precinct is operating at 0.6 of a planet per year. University Campuses are using approximately 1.3 planets per year.

Carbon reduction

Across the project, over 31,100 tonnes of CO² was avoided by specifying low carbon materials, and clever design and construction. 40% less embodied carbon was used for the base building, and 50% less for the fitouts.

ANU Green has updated its [Carbon Smart Event Guide](#), which outlines easy steps to run more sustainable events on and off campus. Events are an important part of the university experience, but they also produce a large amount of greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions. The good news is there are easy steps we can take to have a positive impact.

Many of the suggestions not only reduce our environmental impact but also have lower associated costs while emphasising community engagement.
